Scholarship Criteria:

- Applicant must be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or protected person.
- Applicant must be enrolled as a first year student at an accredited Canadian law school.
- · Applicant must be an HCLA member, in good standing.

Required Application Materials:

- Applicant's official post-secondary transcripts (i.e., undergraduate, graduate, law school);
- · Applicant's resume;
- Cover letter (max. 300 words) outlining the reasons the applicant believes they should be chosen as a scholarship recipient; and
- Name and contact particulars of two (2) references.

Accepting the Award:

 To accept their award, scholarship recipients are expected to attend the applicable event where the scholarships will be formally announced and presented, such as the next Hellenic Professionals' Gala, Annual General Meeting, or another equivalent event.
